Notes:

The preliminary methodology (shown in yellow) counted two individuals per tent and two individuals per vehicle.

On April 27, 2017, the Clean & Safe program adopted the counting methodology used by the Regional Task Force on the Homeless. Per the methodology (represented above by the dark green cells), Clean & Safe staff counted 1.75 individuals per visible tent/structure and 1.66 individuals per vehicle that showed clear signs of habitation.

In May 2018, the Regional Task Force on the Homeless updated the methodology for vehicles to 2.03 that shows clear signs of habitation (the methodology of 1.75 individuals per tent/structure remained the same). The Clean & Safe program implemented this methodology on May 31, 2018 (represented in orange).

In January 2020, the Regional Task Force on the Homeless stopped using methodology for vehicles and structures, however, the Clean & Safe program continues to use the methodology.

In September 2020, the count was performed on September 29th and delayed 6 days due to social unrest and safety concerns. The count was scheduled to be conducted on September 23rd, 2020.

* Denotes the months that The Downtown Fellowship of Ministries and Churches collaborated with us on the monthly homeless sleep count.

- North East East Village is the area north of Market Street & east of Park Ave.
- North West is the area north of Market Street & west of Park Ave.

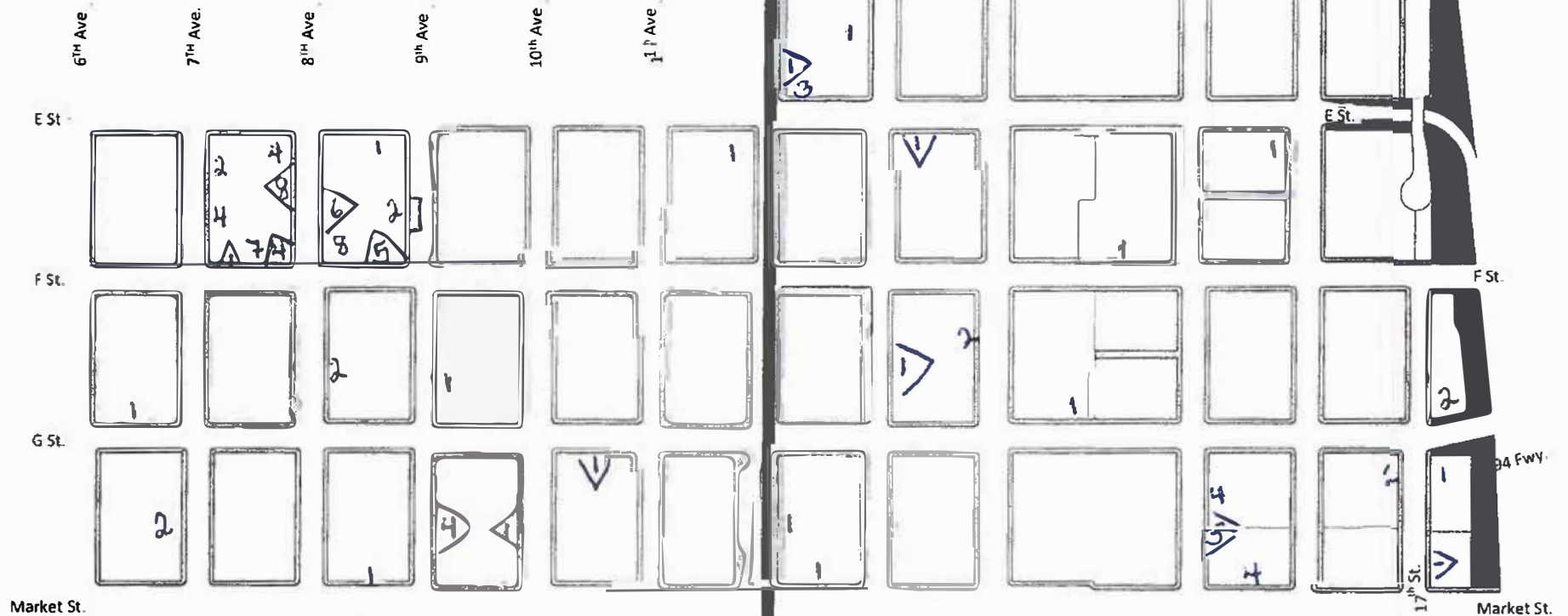
