4.4 Representative Malik Thornton on behalf of Councilmember Whitburn: MT

- Town Hall scheduled for May 8 at 6:30 PM at Casa Del Prado to discuss the department's approach to the upcoming city budget
- Due to budget limitations, requests for non-safety related transportation items (lights, signage, guardrails, metering) are currently suspended
- Measure C will take effect on May 1, increasing the Transient Occupancy Tax (TOT), projected to generate \$82 million annually

5. Hospitality 25 – Hour Minimum Wage SD County Lodging Association: FT

- Highlighted Industry Impacts
 - Minimum wage set at \$25/hour for hospitality workers.
 - Occupancy rates in San Diego remain strong compared to other markets.
 - Average Daily Rates (ADR) continue to rise, driven by inflation and increased labor costs.
 - Discussed how this wage increase may influence the competitive landscape-benefiting larger, well-capitalized hotel groups while squeezing independent operators.
